Sunday, 21st June 2015

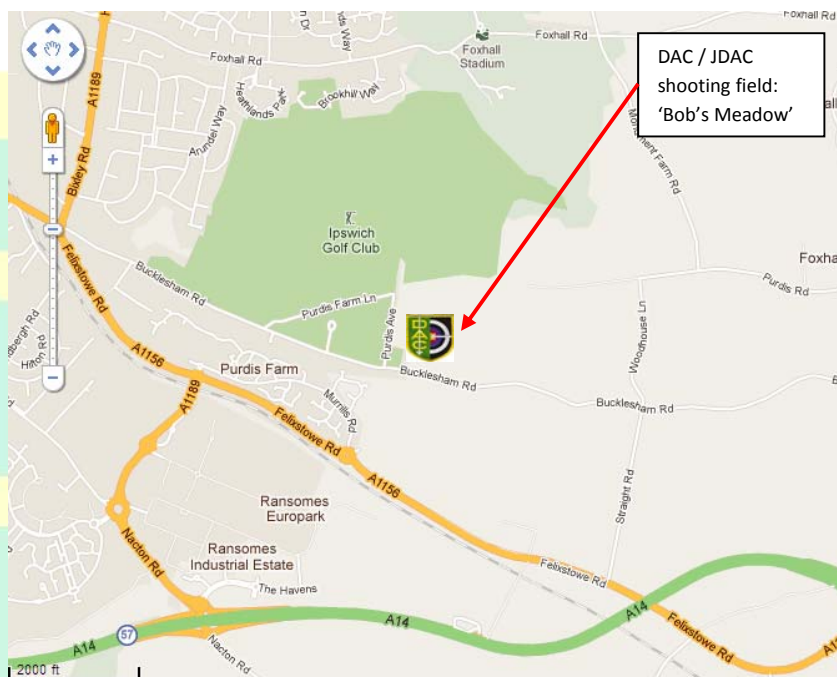
Deben and Junior Deben Archery Clubs would like to invite fellow Suffolk and Essex archers to join us for our second annual Summer Competition.

The competition will involve shooting National Rounds (see below) and will be run according to GNAS rules. This will however be an informal shoot, ideal for both novices and experienced archers. Dress regulations will not apply. Archers and Officers must show their Archery GB / GNAS membership cards when signing in on arrival.

Directions to Bob's Meadow



'Bob's Meadow' is the Deben Archery Club field which is located on Bucklesham Road, just to the west of Foxhall village (NB the field is also the Bucklesham Road car park for Trinity Park during the Suffolk Show for those who know the area).

Coming from Ipswich: Come off into the Bucklesham Rd at the St Augustine's Church roundabout (at the bottom of Bixley Rd). Go up Bucklesham Rd for about 3 miles, passing the golf club and leaving the houses behind. The entrance to the field is to your left just past a patch of woodland: look out for the metal 5-bar gates by the big oak tree and the target signs. The gates also have yellow 'archery in progress' warning signs on them.

Coming from the A12 / A14: At the A12/A14 junction turn on to the A1156 / Felixstowe Road back in towards Ipswich. Pass back over the A14 and almost immediately take a right turn into Straight Road. Follow Straight Road for approx. 1 mile to the crossroads in Foxhall Village. Turn left onto the Bucklesham Road, travelling towards Ipswich. The field is about half a mile outside the village on your right: look out for the metal 5-bar gates by the big oak tree and the target signs. The gates have yellow 'archery in progress' warning signs on them.

The gate must be kept locked at all times but will be manned by a member of Deben Archery Club between 9.15am and 10.30am and then again at the conclusion of the day. Should you need to leave or re-enter the field at any time during the day, please remember to close and lock the gate behind you: this is a Trinity Park requirement, and is also critical to ensure that we minimize the number of unauthorized people on the field who may be injured as a result of unknowingly stepping into the archery range (it is a popular area for dog walkers). The code for the gate padlock will be circulated to club organisers in the week prior to the competition. Please ensure that on locking the gate you re-scramble the padlock. Thank you.
